The Division of Immunology at UCT is internationally recognised for its basic and applied research and is home to a number of award-winning scientists.

Requirements include:

- A minimum academic qualification of a PhD degree in Immunology or a related discipline;
- At least 1 year relevant postdoctoral experience;
- A track record of publishing research outputs;
- Evidence of teaching and student supervision;

Responsibilities include:

- **Teaching**
 - Prepare and deliver lectures and tutorials in Immunology to under-graduate students
 - Prepare and deliver teaching to postgraduate students in the fields of Immunology and infectious diseases.
 - Supervise/co-supervise post-graduate students and postdoctoral fellows in the field of Immunology
 - Course administration and participation in undergraduate Curriculum Design Teams
- **Research**
 - Build an independent research group in a field relevant to the Division of Immunology
 - Conceptualise, lead and execute postgraduate and postdoctoral research projects
 - Train postgraduate students and postdoctoral fellows, develop/expand research collaborations both nationally and internationally
 - Raise research funding, apply for grants from appropriate national and international funding bodies
- **Leadership, management and administration**
 - Perform administrative functions at Divisional, Departmental, Faculty and University level, as needed
- **Social responsiveness**
 - Translate research and findings and teaching practice into the community, for the benefit of the public, where relevant
 - Raise awareness of the relevance of research within the context of health and disease.
