The Department of Obstetrics and Gynaecology at the University of Cape Town offers an opportunity for a registered professional nurse to be involved in the research programme in the Reproductive Medicine Unit.

This is a two-year contract post, in the first instance. The appointment can be full-time or part-time. The salary of the successful applicant will be determined according to experience and based on levels of salary in Pay Class 8 within the University of Cape Town.

The successful applicant will join a team engaged in a variety of research projects and routine clinical work in the field of Reproductive Medicine. The responsibilities of the successful candidate will include patient liaison and communication, the collection of clinical information and data capture and involvement in the co-ordination of clinical research trials. In addition there are certain clinical duties associated with our practice and these include running the Pregnancy Support Clinic and being responsible for the databases for our clinical services.

The requirements of this post include:

- Computer literacy (additional training can be arranged if necessary)
- Excellent interpersonal skills
- The ability to work within a team and also independently
- Ability to manage junior staff
- Willingness to work flexible hours and to contribute to the analysis of data
- Interest and experience in Maternal and Women's Health

Recommendations include:

- Training in good clinical practice (GCP) [this will be arranged if necessary]
- Experience in research based projects

The annual cost of full time employment is between R189 629 – 353 522.

A part-time appointee will receive a pro rata salary based on the number of hours to be worked.
