The Division of Allergology and Clinical Immunology at the Department of Medicine, University of Cape Town, invites applications for a post-doctoral position - this would be a 12-month contract renewable initially for 3 years. **Based at Groote Schuur Hospital**, Cape Town.

This post-doctoral position is embedded within an NIHR-funded global professorship award that is focusing on improving the diagnosis and management of Angioedema across Africa.

In particular, our genomics and laboratory work is focused on understanding the pathophysiology and identifying predictive biomarkers (including urine, plasma or salivary) of ACE- inhibitor related angioedema and cough. In addition, this project explores the role of food additives in driving abnormal mast cell activity and their intersection with abnormal gastrointestinal permeability and infections leading to chronic urticaria and Angioedema conditions.

- PhD in biomedical sciences, skills appropriate for this project including:
 - i) wet lab skills working with enzymatic assays
 - ii) proteomics experience
 - iii) data analytics skills
